## Who Do You Think You Are?

Week 4: We Are Priests Ephesians 4:11-13 Week of May 15, 2022 (Jeff Griffin, Senior Pastor)

We receive a brand-new identity when we trust Christ. Part of that new identity is that we are all priests in God's eyes. Our identity as a priest comes with a great privilege and a great responsibility. We must learn to embrace both.

### Kicking Off:

Who was your first pastor? Tell the group about him.

### **Discussion:**

1. Reread Exodus 19:5-6 "Out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. You will be a kingdom of priests and a holy nation."

Why did God want His people to be a "kingdom of priests?"

2. Reread 1 Peter 2:9 "You are a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession."

In what way is Peter's statement similar to Exodus 19:5-6?

- 3. What happened at the moment of Jesus' death that helped the apostles know that all believers were now priests?
- 4. Reread Hebrews 10:19 "We have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus."

What does it mean for us to "enter the Most Holy Place?"

- 5. What advice would you give to someone desiring to experience God's presence?
- 6. Read Ephesians 4:11-13 "Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, <sup>12</sup> to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up <sup>13</sup> until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

What does this verse tell us about God's vision for clergy and laity?

7. If you have served as a volunteer at church, share of the first volunteer position you filled.
