Psalms – Lyrics for Life

Week 1: His Word

Psalm 19:7-10

Week of January 10, 2021

In our Bible, there is a songbook that is called “Psalms.” It is a collection of lyrics to 150 ancient songs. These lyrics have transformed lives for centuries and they will transform ours as well. In the first week of this new series we studied a psalm that celebrates the beauty and power of the Bible.

Kicking it off: As a young person, Jeff adored the music of a band called “Altar Boys.” Tell your small group of a band that you loved back in high school.

Discussion:

1. Reread *Psalm 19:10a* The decrees of the Lord are more precious than gold, than much pure gold!

How is it possible that a book can be more precious than gold?

2. Reread *Psalm 19:10b* The decrees of the Lord are sweeter than honey, than honey from the honeycomb.

How is it possible that a book can be sweeter than honey?

3. Reread *Psalm 19:7a* The law of the Lord is perfect, refreshing the soul.

How can the Bible “refresh” our soul?

4. Reread *Psalm 19:7b* The statutes of the Lord are trustworthy, making wise the simple.

Can you think of a way that the Bible has increased your wisdom? If so, share with the group.

5. Reread *Psalm 19:8a* The precepts of the Lord are right, giving joy to the heart.

How would you advise someone who wants to experience this verse, yet has found zero joy in personal Bible study?

6. Reread *Psalm 19:8b* The commands of the Lord are radiant, giving light to the eyes.

How can Scripture cast light in one’s life?

Wrapping It Up: Pray together along the lines of *Psalm 119:18* “Open my eyes that I may see wonderful things in your law.”
