Read the following passage:

⁷ To keep me from becoming conceited, I was given a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me. ⁸ Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. ⁹ But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. ¹⁰ That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong. *2 Corinthians 12:7-10 (NIV)*

- 2. Can you think of a "thorn in the flesh" that you are suffering with? If you are willing, tell the group.
- 3. What can we learn about prayer from this passage.

- 5. Can you think of a time that God used a hardship to grow you spiritually? If so, tell the group about it.
- 6. Paul claims to "delight" in trials. Is it realistic for us to strive to find joy in our hardships? If so, how?
