Week 5: When We Wander

1 Samuel 12:1-25

June 6, 2026

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Kicking It Off:

Have you ever gotten physically lost—maybe on a hike, a road trip, or even just in an unfamiliar city—and what was that experience like? How did it feel in the moment, and what eventually helped you find your way back?

Discussion:

1. What stood out to you most from the sermon on *1 Samuel 12:1-25*? Reread for review.
2. What does this message reveal about God's character or His heart for us?
3. How does remembering God's faithfulness in the past help us when we feel like we're starting to wander spiritually today?
4. What is one specific way God might be inviting you to respond this week—whether in your thoughts or habits? What's a potential obstacle, and how could our group support you in taking that step?
5. Looking back over the past few weeks, how have you seen your faith grow or your love for others increase as a result of what God has been teaching through these messages? What's one area where you'd like to see more growth moving forward?

Wrapping It Up:

Take time to share any praise reports, answered prayers, or good news from the week. Then pray for one another—ask God to grow your faith, deepen your love for each other, and equip you to live out what you've heard.
