Tell God about someone that you want to tell about Jesus. Ask God to help you tell that person.



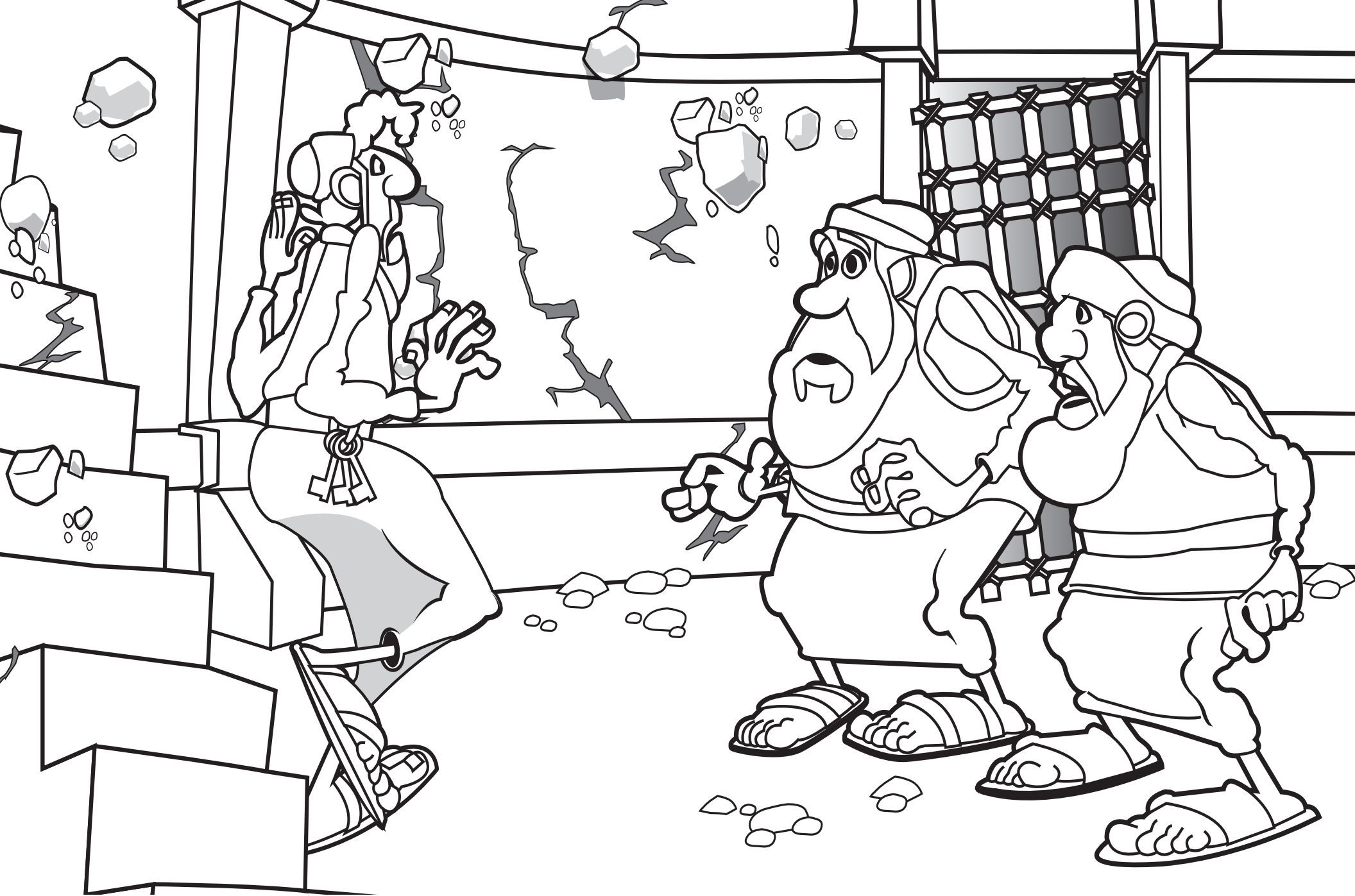
PAUL IS ARRESTED

GROUP ACTIVITY

Paul and Silas in Prison

BIG IDEA: The good news of Jesus is for all people, so we should always be ready to share why we believe.

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Earthquake Shake

Supplies: Building blocks, cookie sheet (1 per group)

Directions: Place the cookie sheet on the floor or table. Have everyone work together in groups of 3-4 kids to build a jail using the building blocks. When finished, have them take turns putting their jail on the cookie sheet. Then have everyone place their hands on the edges of the cookie sheet. When you shout, “Earthquake!” have them begin shaking the cookie sheet while they repeat, “I can boldly tell others about the good news of Jesus.” See how many times they can repeat that before the jail crumbles.

Say: In today’s true Bible story, Paul and Silas were in jail when God sent a BIG earthquake. Instead of escaping, they told the prison guard all about Jesus. Not everyone knows that Jesus loves them. That’s why Jesus wants us to tell others about Him.

Question: Who could you tell about Jesus? What would you tell them?
